You guessed it - I'm writing to announce that your Chamber is taking a page from an old playbook and will publish a printed community map in 2025.

Even as I write this letter to you, I can hear the guffaws of millennials and Gen Xers alike who are inclined to think, "Really, Chris? A map?" We were skeptical too, but as it turns out, there's a real demand for a small, community-based map which serves as a reference to our downtowns, promotes local business, provides easily-readable access for tourists and new workers in the region, has offline usability, and serves as a means of community engagement.

We thought, surely, something simple like this must exist – but as we dug in, we found that apart from the Chamber's latest, which was published in 2015, no other community organization has created a map for our full footprint, which isn't specific to a given interest. We hope to make the Chamber map easy-to-read, easy-to-fold, and easy-to-reference, with a large map of our two-county footprint, spotlights on our downtowns, reference points through the use of QR codes, and limited advertising. We also hope to provide value back to you, our members, offering you one more tool to highlight why our region is so wonderful – to new employees, new visitors, and new customers.
