- Additional River Flood Warnings may be issued later this morning.

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

Hazards	Impacts	Location	Timing
River Flooding	Minor/moderate/major inundation flooding with adjacent road closures.	All of Central Pennsylvania, greatest risk in areas that previously received heavy rainfall	This morning through Thursday morning, crests on mainstem Susquehanna Friday
Inundation Flooding	Roadway ponding and slower travel along with road closures. Low lying and poor drainage flooding.	All of Central Pennsylvania, greatest risk in areas that previously received heavy rainfall	Through tonight




Day 1 Excessive Rainfall Outlook - Wednesday


Flooding Potential | April 3-5, 2024


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### **Radar Estimated Rainfall**

 Areas that have received heavy rainfall will be most susceptible to flooding.




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### Juniata River Basin

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




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## West Branch Susquehanna River Basin

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




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### Mainstem Susquehanna River Basin

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
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
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## Lower Susquehanna River Basin Tributaries

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- Additional 1.5-2.5" of rainfall today will maintain an elevated risk of inundation and river flooding to central and eastern Pennsylvania through tonight.
- Minor to moderate river flooding is forecast on smaller streams and creeks across basins in south-central Pennsylvania. There could be additional Flood Warnings posted later this morning.
- Significant rises are expected on the mainstem Susquehanna with crests near minor flood stage on Friday.
