Ken began his employment at the Danville Borough in January of 2022. In a little less than two short years he has simplified and improved on many of the daily functions of the Danville Borough Code Department. He is responsible for locating approximately 225 new rentals in the Borough, bringing in additional revenue of \$11,000 annually. He is also responsible for the demolition of four blighted residential buildings in the Borough which will open opportunities for new development and growth within the community. Ken has been an instrumental part of closing out the Mahoning Creek Levee certification process, resulting in lower or no insurance premiums at all. He has placed the Danville Borough in the State and National spotlight with highlighting the Borough's flood mitigation steps taken over the years through publishing an article that was sent out to all Pennsylvania Municipal Governments. Also, by taking part in a documentary in cooperation with the U.S. Army Core of Engineers and FEMA highlighting steps taken by the borough to safeguard the residents since Agnus. The video is permanently posted in the 50th anniversary of Hurricane Agnus Memorial site.
